REPORT ON THE REDDING POLICE DEPARTMENT, JULY 1-DECEMBER 31, 2002

Included in the report was the mission statement and code of ethics, traffic safety initiatives, web site information, an analysis of accidents on "scenic roads", and grants that have been applied for and grants that have been received.

DISCUSSION OF AMENDED SCENIC ROAD ORDINANCE

Motion: That the Board of Selectmen appoint Dan Carter to the Park and Recreation to fill the remaining term of Harry Adamakos which runs until June 30, 2004 Cotton, Ketcham. Approved. Unanimous.
